



What are the shelves made of?

The shelves are made of 6 mm thick tempered Float glass, resistant to moisture, scratches, and damage. They are perfect for any room. The maximum load of the shelf is 12 kg, with the weight evenly distributed across two brackets (6 kg on each bracket).

Before starting the installation

Make sure the wall where the shelf will be mounted is even and stable, allowing the brackets to be properly fixed. It should be suitable for the weight of the shelf itself as well as its maximum allowable load of 12 kg. – If in doubt, choose appropriate wall plugs or consult a professional. The wall must be free from major damage, such as cracks or holes, which could affect the durability of the installation.

Step-by-step instructions

1. Measure and mark the wall where the brackets will go, keeping symmetry and level. 2. Use a drill bit sized for the wall plugs (e.g., 6 mm) and drill holes about 35–40 mm deep. 3. Insert the wall plugs and fix the brackets by screwing in the screws evenly. 4. Place the shelf between layers of white, soft rubber on both the top and bottom of the bracket, checking that it is level. 5. Gently tighten the brackets to keep the shelf stable, avoiding excessive pressure that could damage the glass.

Cleaning and maintenance

Clean the shelf with a soft cloth and a mild cleaning agent, e.g., window cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals and sharp tools to prevent damage to the surface.

Important! Observe safety precautions when using the product.

The product is made of glass, so handle it carefully to avoid breakage or damage. Do not place it in areas subject to strong shocks or vibrations – it may fall and break. Mount on a stable, properly prepared surface using the included components. Keep the product away from children – broken glass can cause injury. The set contains small parts (e.g., screws, wall plugs) which may be hazardous if swallowed. Do not disassemble or modify the shelf. If the glass cracks or chips appear, stop using immediately. When moving the shelf, hold it by its edges only – do not lift by mounting parts or accessories. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in product damage or injury.
